ROMANIAN TOUR PROGRAM & ITENERARY:

March 12, Saturday – Sofia to Veliko Tarnovo:

Private coach from Sofia to Veliko Tarnovo. On the way stop and sightseeing tour of Veliko Tarnovo, former Bulgarian Capital, with many remarkable and historical places - sightseeing tour of the town. Optional visit of Tzarevets (entrance to be paid at the site)

Coach to Arbanassi – an architectural reserve – for a sightseeing walk. Visit of the church and Konstanzalieva house. We have lunch and wine tasting in Arbanassi Restaurant. Afternoon is free in Veliko Tarnovo. Accommodations and dinner at Hotel Bolyarski Rachev (4★) or Yantra (4★).

March 13, Sunday – Veliko Tarnovo to Giurgiu to Bucharest:

Danubius coach from Veliko Tarnovo to Bucharest, crossing the border into Romania.

Upon arrival in Bucharest, the capital of Romania, receive orientation sightseeing including the Parliament Palace inside visit and Village Museum and lunch. Accommodations are at Crowne Plaza hotel (5★) with dinner at a local restaurant.

March 14, Monday – Bucharest to Curtea de Arges to Sibiu:

We leave Bucharest through its western side heading toward Transylvania. The first stop will be at Curtea de Arges to visit the monastery, one of the most important monuments of medieval art in this part of Romania, the tombs of the Romanian kings are to be found there - a very impressing and romantic Romanian legend is connected to this monastery, the symbol of man sacrifice for the sake of art and everlasting creation. Lunch will be served after the visit. This is the day when you will continuously get the flavour of romanticism and legend. Depart to Sibiu via Cozia Monastery. A short break at Cozia to visit the 14th Century Church; the Tomb of Prince Mircea the Wise, one of the first princess of Europe that fought against the enlargement of the Ottoman Empire to the North of the Danube river. We arrive in the afternoon at Sibiu (European Cultural Capital in 2007) and accommodation in a (4★) Ramada or Golden Tulip Hotel. Dinner will be served at the Tower restaurant, a historic building situated in the Grand Ring – centre of the town.

March 15, Tuesday – Sibiu to Medias, then Biertan and finally to Sighisoara:

We will experience the beauties of the Brukenthal museum in the centre of Sibiu or if you feel like walking you can have a walking tour of the medieval walls (*the group may be split one part with the group guide will go for a walk, the other part will visit the museum accompanied by the English speaking guide of the museum*). First stop, Biertan, which is one of the first German settlements in Transylvania, mentioned in the Andreean Diploma from the year 1224 AD. You will be in the centre of the village and visit the German fortified church. From here we go to Sighisoara. You will stop within the walls of the sole inhabited medieval site in Europe. Sighisoara is Vlad the Impaler's (Dracula) hometown. You will visit the birthplace of Dracula an afterwards have a guided walk in the medieval centre. You will visit of the Clock Tower with its museum of history, the clock, the torture chamber and the weaponry room. Accommodations will be in a (4★) hotel and dinner will be served in the house where Dracula was born.

March 16, Wednesday – Sighisoara to Brasov:

Travel to Brasov, known during the medieval times as “Kronstadt.” It was one of the most important cross-roads in the middle of Romania, dating back in the 13th century with a large Saxon population. We start with a sightseeing tour of the town, which includes St. Nicholas Church and the first Romanian School in Transylvania, the Black Church, and the centre of the city. We lunch in a restaurant with local specific – The Hunter's House. With the long shadows of the afternoon you will enter Bran Castle, known as Dracula's Castle. After the visit you can spend time buying souvenirs in the nearby bazaar. From here we travel to Poiana Brasov, nicknamed the pearl of the Romanian mountain resorts. Accommodations are in (4★) Ana Hotel, Poiana Brasov. Dinner will be with local specific and folk-music.

March 17, Thursday – Coach to Sinaia and Bucharest:

Depart for Sinaia, visit Peles castle, the summer residence of the Romanian Royal Family until 1948. It is constructed in a composite of styles in the second half of the 19th century. We have lunch in the castle. After lunch we leave for Bucharest for free time in the centre of the town and a shopping tour. Accommodations and dinner will be at (5★) Crowne Plaza Hotel.

March 18, Friday – Tour museum then off to airport for home:

As per the flight schedule, a visit to George Enescu Museum – situated close to the centre of the town - may be organized and then on the way to the Bucharest airport. Flight to Zurich for overnight stay at the Zurich airport 4 star Novotel hotel. *George Enescu was a famous Romanian composer, violinist, and piano player.*
