ITINERARY CHANGES, DEVIATIONS: Passengers requesting an itinerary that differs from the group must submit their request in writing up to 60 days prior to departure. Holiday Ski Tours (800-526-2827, sales@holidayze.com) will, in turn, advise on their options as well as any additional costs that may apply. However, it must be noted that airline tariffs will only allow a maximum of 10-20%, depending on the airline involved, of group total to deviate from the original confirmed itinerary. Also, please note that deviations can be requested for return flights only

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: All U. S. Citizens participating in this tour program are required to have a U. S. Passport valid for at least 6 months *beyond* the return date of the tour. Any non-U. S. Citizens participating in this tour must check with the appropriate consulate for all countries being visited and transited, to ensure that they have met all entry requirements. It is the participant's responsibility to be sure that all proper entry requirements are met and that they have all the appropriate documents necessary.

AIRLINE SEATING: It is customary for the airlines to allocate a section (or block) of seats when booking groups. It is understood that the group is usually seated in this block of seats and requests for aisle or window seats cannot always be accommodated due to the limitations required by the seat block. Requests for special seats can be taken, but cannot be guaranteed. Exit row and/or bulkhead seating can only be assigned at the airport.

AIRLINE TARIFFS: Airfare in conjunction with this program is the actual airfare in effect for 2012, however these are still subject to change until booked. Airfares do not include departure taxes, customs, agricultural and airport PFC's which are indicated above and subject to change until time of ticketing. However, rates may be affected by subsequent surcharges deemed necessary by various government agencies or by airlines due to increases for fuel charges or other reasons beyond our control. Airline taxes are subject to change until ticket is issued. Airfares are subject to change.

ADDITIONAL FLIGHT INFORMATION: Please note that the Morocco tours include flights on low cost European airline EasyJet. EasyJet is quite strict on baggage allowances and each passenger is only allowed to bring one carryon bag which must be able to fit under the seat and one additional piece of checked baggage which cannot weigh more than 20Kilos or 44 lbs. It will be possible to store a bag at the hotel at Geneva Airport during the time in Morocco for pick up during the return stay. This service will incur an additional charge of \$50. Per bag.

SKI EQUIPMENT: It is STRONGLY recommended that participants going to Morocco after Chamonix should NOT bring ski equipment as each extra bag is going to cost \$50. For storage, as indicated above, this equipment cannot be brought on the EasyJet flights.

TICKETS AND FINAL DOCUMENTS: Upon receipt of all completed information and final payment, documents and tickets will be sent about 14 days prior to departure unless alternate arrangements have been made. Please contact FWSA International Travel to be sure that documentation will be sent in accordance with your needs.

TRIP CANCELLATION/INTERRUPTION INSURANCE: Trip cancellation insurance is available and **is highly recommended**. The premium depends on the amount of coverage desired and is based on the tour cost as indicated and will cover all non-refundable amounts in the event of a covered cancellation or trip interruption up to the amount of coverage selected, plus the following additional coverage:

Day 1 : Geneva/Casablanca.

Depart Geneva on EasyJet for Casablanca. Meet and greet at Casablanca airport, then transfer to your hotel to check in. Later today will be dedicated to discovering the economic capital of the kingdom and its largest city. The orientation tour will include an outside visit to the splendid Hassan II Mosque: a breathtaking landmark of Casablanca with the tallest minaret at 210m. Continue along the Ain Diab Corniche. Then on to Habous Charter, the oldest area in Casablanca and the setting of the Royal Palace before continuing on to the Mohammed V Square. Overnight in Casablanca

Day 2 : Casablanca - Rabat - Meknes - Volubilis - Fes.

After breakfast, depart to Rabat by highway. After about 75 minutes drive, arrival to the heart of the political capital of the kingdom. Begin your discovery of this imperial city with a walk around the entrance to the Royal Palace with its massive doors, well decorated buildings and lovely gardens. Next to the palace, you will see the impressive Mohammed V Mausoleum: the burial ground of the two late Alouite kings - Mohammed V and Hassan II. In the same area, you will find the Tour, the landmark of Rabat and one of the oldest mosques ever. Depart from Rabat along vast agricultural fields to the second imperial city of Meknes to take pictures of the massive Bab El Mansour gate. The city tour of Meknes includes the Harri Souani stables, the old medina and the beautiful royal palace. Then continue on to the sacred city of Mouly Idriss. You will have some time to rest at this beautiful small city before visiting the Roman ruins of Volubilis. Volubilis is a truly impressive setting selected by UNESCO as a cultural heritage site for humanity. After your visit depart for the great city of Fes for overnight.

Day 3 : Fes.

Enjoy a full day tour of Fes with a local guide. Fes is Morocco's spiritual and intellectual capital and has the largest old Medina in the world. The city's numerous monuments have thousands of stories to tell visitors, the Jemaa Karaouyne (the first university to be established in the world), The Mederssa Bounania, the El tanneries and artisan quarters and the fascinating souks are just some of the many places to see. Overnight in Fes

Day 4 : Fes - Midelt – Erfoud - Merzouga.

Leaving Fez with its great history, we will head to a totally different part of Morocco. On the way to Erfoud we will pass through many villages. The first being to Imouzer el Kandari which was built by the French authorities in the early 20th century, and it was arranged as a smaller version of Ifrane. The town lies at 1350, then Ifrane known as Morocco's Switzerland, is a very beautiful city with charming European style houses. Continuation via Midelt, the Ziz River and a series of fortified villages before arriving in Erfoud. Participants will have to leave the busses and continue to Merzouga sand dunes by 4x4 cars then on camel back to spend night under tents in a small Oasis for an overnight in your bivouac site of a carpeted Berber tents. First things first, a glass of mint tea once our packs are being unloaded. Our tagine dinner is prepared and, after dessert, tea or coffee, all around our romantic camp fire, - it can get cold at night! – we can chat or sing along to our heart's content.

Day 5 : Merzouga – Erfoud – Tinghir – Boumalen Dades.

In early morning, climb the sand dunes in order to admire the splendid sun rise on the top of the dunes. Back to your camp for Berber Breakfast under tents. The participants will participate to a 2/3 hour excursion in the desert by 4x4 cars through the sand-sea dunes near the Algerian border where you can have the chance to take photos and see the black volcanic rock, also you may meet a nomad families and see their nomadic lifestyle. Back to your bus in Erfoud and drive directly to Tinghir via Tinjdad. Tinghir has a very beautiful and large oasis that is more than 40 km in length. The valley is rich with palm trees, olives, almonds and many other crops and a few minutes walk through the green valley is a remarkable experience. North of Tinghir is Todra Gorge, a 300m cut deep wall into the mountains of the High Atlas and one of the rarest landscapes. Continue to the village of Boumalen Dades. Dinner and overnight.

Day 6 : Boumalen - El Kelaa - Skoura – Ouarzazate / Marrakech

After breakfast, continue the tour via Dades valley and El Kella Mgouna. The latter is a large village famous for cultivating roses. Every year the villages celebrate rose with a festival attended by hundreds of people from all over the world. We will continue our tour to Morocco's version of Hollywood, Ouarzazate, stop for visiting Kasbah Ait Benhaddou. Continue to Marrakech. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

Day 07 : Marrakech.

We have a full day guided tour of Marrakech including the famous Jemaa El Fna square with its array of foods, snake charmers, music players and fortune tellers. We then visit the Koutoubia Mosque (12th century), Bahia Palace and Menara Gardens. You will also have time during the tour to walk through the amazing old Medina. Overnight in Marrakech

Day 08 : Marrakech - airport.

After breakfast we will transfer you to the airport for your departure flight on Easy Jet to Geneva. Upon arrival in Geneva transfer by hotel shuttle bus to the NH Hotel Geneva Airport.

Day 01 : Geneva/Casablanca.

Depart Geneva on EasyJet for Casablanca. Meet and greet at Casablanca airport, then transfer to your hotel to check in. Later today will be dedicated to discovering the economic capital of the kingdom and its largest city. The orientation tour will include an outside visit to the splendid Hassan II Mosque : a breathtaking landmark of Casablanca with the tallest minaret at 210m. Continue along the Ain Diab Corniche, then on to Habous district, the oldest area in Casablanca and the setting of the Royal Palace before continuing on to the Mohammed V Square. Overnight in Casablanca

Day 02 : Casablanca - Rabat.

After breakfast, depart Casablanca along the coast line to the political capital of Morocco: Rabat. Begin your discovery of this imperial city with a walk around the entrance to the Royal Palace with its massive doors, well decorated buildings and lovely gardens. Next to the palace, you will see the impressive Mohammed V Mausoleum: the burial ground of the two late Alouite kings - Mohammed V and Hassan II. In the same area, you will find the Tour, the landmark of Rabat and one of the oldest mosques ever. Check in at your hotel for overnight.

Day 03 : Rabat – Tangier (298 km)

Breakfast and drive directly to Tangier "The old international city situated in the north of the country, only a 2 hour Ferry ride from Spain". Lunch on your own upon arrival and afternoon visit of Tangier : It is worth while seeing the old medina which represents a prime example of a compact unit of immense cultural importance. These world-famous streets have a great number of houses of worship. Also to be seen: the American Legation Museum, located in the oldest American consulate in continuous use. Other points of interest in Tangier are the Kasbah as well as surrounding area of the city with Hercules caves and cap Spartel. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 04: Tangier – Tetouan – Chefchaouen (118km)

After breakfast, departure for Tetouan. Visit of the city : the old medina as well as the splendid and large coast, as Tetouan coast is considered one of the largest beach resorts of the country. On your own for lunch then continue to Chefchaouen. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 05: Chefchaouen – Ouazzane - Meknes – Fez (249km)

After breakfast, we will visit chefchaouen, a beautiful city located 40 60 KM south of Tetouan. Chefchaouen has a history of Spanish-influence and is located in the heart of the Rif Mountains, where surrounding trees, hills, springs, and wildflowers attract visitors looking for a calm getaway. Chefchaouen offers also the nature lover rows of hills perfect for hiking and outdoor activities. Continue onto the city of Ouazzane. This is a Jewish holy city well known by the sanctuary of a Jewish Saint venerated by both Muslims and Jews, Rabbi Amram Ben Diwan. Drive to Fes Meknes "the Moroccan Versailles" which was founded at the end of the 17th Century by Moulay Ismail. Visit of My Ismail mausoleum as well as the Medina. Continue to Fes. Dinner and overnight in the hotel.

Day 06: Fes.

Enjoy a full day tour of Fes with a local guide. Fes is Morocco's spiritual and intellectual capital and has the largest old Medina in the world. The city's numerous monuments have thousands of stories to tell visitors, the Jemaa Karaouyne (the first university to be established in the world), The Mederssa Bounania, the El tanneries and artisan quarters and the fascinating souks are just some of the many places to see. Overnight in Fes

Day 07: Fes - Midelt - Erfoud.

Leaving Fes with its great history, we will head to a totally different part of Morocco. On the way to Erfoud we will pass through many Berber cities and villages. We will continue via Midelt, the Ziz River and a series of fortified villages before arriving in Erfoud for an overnight.

Day 08: Erfoud/Merzouga

In the morning after breakfast, your excursion will start from the hotel taking you through the sand-sea dunes near the Algerian border where you can have the chance to take photos and see the black volcanic rock, also you may meet a nomad family and see their nomadic lifestyle. We set out half an hour later for an hour's drive in our 4WD towards the south, crossing the Oued Ziz, First along a Tarmacadam road for some 16km, then another 35km of sandy piste trails carved out of the sandy crust by motorbikes and other adventurous vehicles to the tiny desert town of Merzouga in an

enormous palmeraie. We shall see, in a dramatic line almost perfectly from north to south, the incredible panorama of the sea of sand dunes of the Erg Chebbi.

Once we've arrived at Merzouga, we alight to enjoy a traditional welcoming glass, or two, of mint tea at the Auberge du Sud whilst your baggage is being loaded onto the pack animals. At around 4pm (winter) we set off, one person per dromedary, across a sea of golden dunes. This is the only 'true' desert area of the kingdom of Morocco and an area where meteorites continue to be found, as were crocodile teeth, shark, and pterosaur and spinosaurus fossils. We stop in the middle of nowhere to witness, from the high dunes, Nature's incredible light show of sunset over ever-changing colours of dunes, to continue on under the star-filled heavens to our bivouac site of a carpeted Berber tent in a small oasis. First things first, a glass of mint tea once our packs are being unloaded. Our Tagine dinner is prepared and, after dessert, tea or coffee, all around our romantic camp fire, - it can get cold at night! – we can chat or singalong to our heart's content.

Day 09: Merzouga - Erfoud – Tinghir – Boumalen Dades

Early morning camel ride at sunrise in the desert. Return back to the bivouac for breakfast before driving to Erfoud by 4WD to catch the bus and drive to Tinghir via Rissani and Tinjdad. Tinghir has a very beautiful and large oasis that is more than 40 km in length. The valley is rich with palm trees, olives, almonds and many other crops and a few minutes' walk through the green valley is a remarkable experience. North of Tinghir is Todra Gorge, a 300m cut deep wall into the mountains of the High Atlas and one of the rarest landscapes. By the end of afternoon, continue to Boumalen Dades. Dinner and Overnight.

Day 10: Boumalen Dades - El Kelaa - Skoura - Ouarzazate.

After breakfast, continue the tour via El Kella Mgouna. The latter is a large village famous for cultivating roses. Every year the villages celebrate rose with a festival attended by hundreds of people from all over the world. We will continue our tour to Morocco's version of Hollywood, Ouarzazate for overnight

Day 11: Ouarzazate – Marrakech.

Ouarzazate, in Berber literally means without noise, is a very charming city. As Morocco's Hollywood, Ouarzazate with its cinematographic studios offers a great environment for big film shoots such as Gladiators, Astérix ET Obélix, Lawrence of Arabia and Jesus of Nazareth. Ouarzazate is also a city of beautiful Kasbahs and great history. In the city centre we will enjoy a visit to the magnificent Tourirt

Kasbah and Kasbah Tifoultout, some of the few remaining Glaoui residences. PM continue to Marrakech. Dinner and overnight in your hotel.

Day 12: Marrakech.

After breakfast we have a full day guided tour of Marrakech including the famous Jemaa El Fna square with its array of foods, snake charmers, music players and fortune tellers. We then visit the Koutoubia Mosque (12th century), Bahia Palace and Menara Gardens. You will also have time during the tour to walk through the amazing old Medina. Overnight in Marrakech

Day 13: Marrakech – Oukaimden - Marrakech

Enjoy a free day to relax or excursion to Oukaimden for skiing – back to Marrakech in late afternoon. Dinner & Overnight.

Day 14: Marrakech - airport.

After breakfast we will transfer you to the airport for your departure flight via EasyJet to Geneva. Upon arrival in Geneva, transfer by hotel shuttle bus to the NH Hotel Geneva Airport. Remainder of day at leisure.

Day 15: Geneva Airport:

Take the hotel shuttle bus to Geneva Airport to check in for your return flight on Swiss International Airlines or Air France to the US.
