HAPPY BIRTHDAY KLAUS OBERMEYER: *Klaus Obermeyer*, the name and face of the *Obermeyer* brand, turned 103 on December 2nd. Klaus founded Sport Obermeyer based on insights he had gained about skiwear while working as an instructor and started the business in the attic of his home. One of the first of many innovations was a down ski parka, stitched together from his own goose-down comforter. After that came suntan lotion, turtlenecks, nylon wind-shirts, mirrored sunglasses, the Boot Fit Press and more. In 1961, the first Sport Obermeyer factory warehouse opened in Aspen, and the innovations continued with “soft-shell” jackets, double lens goggles, and much more. Klaus was inducted into the U.S. National Ski and Snowboard Hall of Fame in 1997. He was also inducted into the Colorado Business Hall of Fame in 2015 by Junior Achievement-Rocky Mountain and the Denver Metro Chamber of Commerce.

FAR WEST SAYS GOODBYE TO ONE OF OUR FAVORITE 10TH MOUNTAIN MEN: *Bruce Campbell*, a long-time member and co-founder of Grindelwald Ski Club, and friend to many of us in Far West, made his last trip up the mountain on November 22nd. Bruce was 98 years old. He, along with fellow 10th Mountain Division member, Howard Koch, attended several Far West Conventions over the years, the last one in October, 2021, in San Diego, where we helped Bruce celebrate his 96th birthday. Bruce stayed active with the 10th Mountain Division and was the narrator of the 2021 Production of the Chris Anthony film “*Mission Mt. Mangart*”, the story of the taking of Riva Ridge during World War Two. Bruce had an incredible radio voice and was the perfect choice to do the voice over. A memorial service is being planned for some time in January. You can read Bruce’s bio on the Far West website, under Publications/Delegate Book 2021.

SKI INDUSTRY SAYS GOODBYE TO ONE OF THEIR OWN: Bill “Luke” Lewkowitz died on November 22, in Wickenburg, Arizona, at the age of 65. Bill captured the spirit of Jackson Hole, appearing in movies and magazines, and landing a position with Jackson Hole Mountain resort, where we worked for 30 years. His first job was that of a Ski Host, then overseeing sales, securing sponsorships for the resort, and planning major events such as Powder 8s, Ski-Joring, and the Rendezvous Mountain Festival. Bill’s life was all about skiing, cowboy life, and live music. Retiring in 2020, Bill looked forward to spending time with his wife, Natalie, between Wickenburg and Jackson Hole, bringing together families and communities. A celebration of life will be held on February 2nd.

SKI GROUP’S NEW STAFF: As we reported in July, Stephen Hall, owner and President of Skigroup.Net, passed away due to a lengthy battle with cancer. Skigroup has just announced that Stephen’s son, Dylan Van-Leuwen-Hall, has taken over as the CEO of the company.
