WHO & WHAT'S NEW FOR 2019

Lindsey Vonn: The Final Season: An intimate recounting of the iconic skier's last competitive campaign while looking back on her transcendent career, from child prodigy to decorated Olympian to global superstar, debuts Tuesday, November 26 (10:00-11:30 p.m. EST/PST), exclusively on HBO. This film traces Vonn's exhilarating story from her childhood in Minnesota, all the way to the World Championships in Are, Sweden, this past February, for what proved to be the epilogue of her amazing career, as she earned bronze in her final event. Teton Gravity Research (TGR), widely recognized as one of the premier documentary production companies in the outdoor action, adventure, and exploration space, had a camera crew embedded with Vonn throughout the winter months, capturing the final, intimate moments of her skiing journey. 2020 NORTH AMERICAN SKI WEEK: We'll be going to *Big Sky, Montana*, for 2020 North American Ski Week. Far West 2020 ADVENTURE TRIP: Far West will be offering an Adventure trip to *Croatia*, September 3-13, 2020. We will be working with *Alpine Adventures* on this particular trip. This will be a land and boat/yacht trip, limited to a minimum of 30, and maximum of 40 participants. Group air is not available until October, 2019. Once that happens, marketing materials will be put out to FWSA clubs and councils.

FWSA 2021 SOLDEN SKI WEEK: This trip will have an extension to *Southern Spain*. Three bids have been submitted, and bid comparison analysis is currently being worked on.

FWSA SUMMER 2021 CHILE SKI/ADVENTURE TRIP: Valle Nevado, Chile ski trip with extension to Atacama Desert currently being researched for details of Atacama Desert conditions. Possible dates would be late July or August, 2021.

OTHER FWSA INTERNATIONAL TRIPS UNDER CONSIDERATION: FWSA International Ski Week, 2022 to *Madonna Di Campiglio*, *Italy* was voted on at April, 2019 Board meeting. An *Africa Adventure Trip* has been approved for 2022, going to central and east Africa. And, a *Galapagos Adventure Trip* has been approved by the FWSA Board for 2024.

FWSF CONVENTION NEWS: The Far West Ski Foundation held its annual meeting June 13, 2019 at the start of the Far West convention. Joe Harvis was named a Trustee and Sandra Knapp the Recording Secretary. The Foundation was quite busy at this year's convention. In addition to Scholarship grants in the name of 19 racers totaling \$16750, grants of \$500 each were authorized for the High Fives Foundation, Disabled Sports Eastern Sierra and Big White Adaptive (first time three such were grants were made in one FWSF meeting). Grants of \$500 were each made to the Squaw Valley Museum Foundation and to the California Ski Library, as well. The Friday silent wine auction raised enough for an adaptive grant. Joe Harvis, assisted by Tom Bundgard, conducted the auction after our Friends helped set up the venue and banners.

During the Sunday General Session of FWSA, a number of continuing and NEW contributions for scholarships were made.

HISTORIC SKI CLUBS AND COUNCIL, 2019: Five clubs and San Diego Council were authorized the designation "Historic" at the FWSA convention June 16, 2019. This brings the Historic total to 28 clubs and two councils; the roster remains open for additions in 2020. The Historic Bay Area Council presented Modesto (1936), Marin (1938) and Nisei (1958); Orange presented Orange County SC (1964) and San Diego presented Torrey Pines (1961) and the San Diego Council itself (1963). There are a lot of eligible clubs in BAC and LA Council. All you need to furnish to the History Chairman is: 1) an application, 2) proof of founding date 50 or more years ago and in continuous operation and 3) a high definition digital logo.
