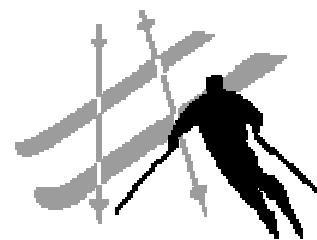

Interlaken, Switzerland

Interlaken is an excellent place from which to explore the central region of the Bernese Oberland. This small town lays between two lakes, Lake Thun and Lake Brienz and above the triple peaks of Jungfrau, Mönch and Eiger mountains.



The Jungfrau region is considered the birthplace of skiing and offers some of the most challenging slopes in Switzerland.

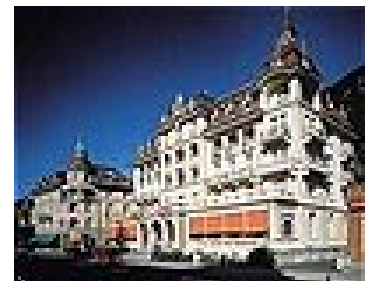


The area has Downhill skiing, Snowboarding, Devalkart, Cross-Country, Tobogganing, Ice skating, Snow-shoe hike, Winter hike, and Husky Sledge Ride.



Ride the Jungfrau Railway, the highest railway in Europe, at 11,000 feet, it is considered one of the most interesting of all mountain lines. The first section of the line is in the open air, but beyond Eigergletscher it runs through a great tunnel (4-3/4 miles long), piercing the limestone and gneiss rock of the Eiger, Mönch, and Jungfrau. At the top, there is a restaurant that provides a 360° panoramic view of the amazing glacier world.

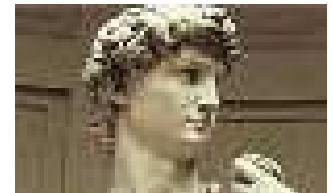
