**FAR WEST SKI ASSOCIATION CONDUCTS
BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING IN SNOWBIRD, UTAH**

SNOWBIRD, UTAH: The Far West Ski Association conducted its winter Board of Directors and Board of Trustees meetings November 30th to December 2nd, 2007 at the Cliff Lodge in Snowbird, Utah. The Far West Ski Association, founded in 1930, is a non-profit organization representing 175 affiliated ski clubs located throughout ten regional councils in the states of Arizona, California, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, and Washington. The Association conducts active programs in public affairs, skier safety, ski heritage, athletics, racing, communications, travel, council development, ski industry, and community outreach.

At the December meeting of the Far West Ski Association Board of Directors, the newly formed Intermountain Ski Council, consisting of five ski clubs in Utah and Idaho, became an official affiliated council of the Far West Ski Association. The Association now represents 11 councils, approximately 180 ski clubs and 49,000 ski club members.
