U.S. Ski Hall of Fame Names New Leader: Tom Kelly, Vice President of Communications for US Ski and Snowboard Association has been elected as the new Chairman of the Board for the U.S. Ski Hall of Fame. Learn to Ski and Snowboard/Bring a Friend: The organizers of the Learn to Ski and

Snowboard/Bring a Friend initiative have updated and re-launched the initiative's web presence. New features enable folks to more easily find information from ski/snowboard areas and retail shops. The site originally focused specifically on the month of January, which was "Learn to Ski and Snowboard Month". Initiative partners wanted the flexibility to better promote learning programs that take place at other times since lessons from professional instructors are available all winter long. "Our goal is to encourage taking lessons from professional instructors," said Raelene Davis, VP of Marketing for Ski Utah and chair of the initiative. "January still will be 'Learn to Ski and Snowboard Month' because many ski and snowboard areas like to offer their best learning deals then. It's a great PR hook that enables us to focus the public's attention and the industry's attention on a specific time frame. Vail Resorts Acquires Park City Mountain Resort: Vail Resorts is the new owner of *Park City Mountain Resort*. With the purchase, this now makes Park City the country's largest ski resort, covering more than 7,000 acres. Vail announced their acquisition of PCMR on September 4th, adding that the sale resolves all litigation with Powdr Corp. "Ending that dispute will provide assurance to the guests and employees of PCMR - and to everyone in the Park City Community - that they no longer have to worry about any disruption to the operation of the resort" said Vail CEO, Rob Katz. The agreement includes the retention of all PCMR employees in their current roles. It's great to finally have this all settled for the 2015 ski season, and add one more resort to the "Epic" family.

Far West Ski Foundation Plans for Giving: Everyone gives to their favorite cause or charity in some way or another each year.
