Steve Bellamy is a creative sports and media entrepreneur known for founding The Tennis Channel and The Ski Channel television networks. He has been involved in the production of 1000's of hours of television and film, and has produced, directed, written and hosted numerous television shows and films.

The film he recently wrote, produced and directed entitled “The Story” about a diverse group of people who have devoted their lives to the mountains, is garnering critical awards and is being pushed through the Academy Award nomination process.

As an avid evangelist of lifetime sports, promoting skiing and tennis has been his life's work. In the tennis world, Bellamy was one of the top 10 most influential people in the sport by Sports Business Journal. And the Tennis News Person of the Year Award, which is given to the influential person in the sport every year, is called the “Bellamy Award” in his honor. He won the award in 2005. For years he sat on every major board

and could be seen regularly on ESPN and other news outlets prognosticating on tennis.

He has been given a plethora of awards including a proclamation from the Mayor of Los Angeles, the key to the City of Las Vegas and the Distinguished Entrepreneur Award from the Kelly School of Business at Indiana University where he was also the commencement speaker.
