INDY PASS TO GROW IN 2024-2025: The Indy Pass went on sale March 8, 2024 at \$279 to current and past passholders. Those on last year's waitlist can buy it for \$329. Indy Pass currently has 185 independent resort partners, and the company is offering a money-back guarantee that it will grow to at least 200 partners for 2024-25. Seven new alpine resorts have been added to the Indy Pass for the 2024-25 season, including: Big Moose Mountain, ME, Mt. Eyak, AK, Mt. Washington Alpine Resort, B.C. Powderhorn Mountain Resort, CO., Steeplechase, MN., Wintergreen Resort, VA and Wisp Resort, MD. New discounted cat skiing operations Include: Big Red Cats, BC, Selkirk Powder, ID, Brundage Mountain Snowcat Adventures, ID, Soldier Mountain Cat Skiing, ID, and Cascade Powder Guides, WA. Pass holders can get 10 percent off when they book day seats or packaged visits at 5 resorts. Indy recontracts with its pass partners each season and has not yet released a list of participating resorts for next season. "This process takes time," said Indy Pass founder Doug Fish, "but we are confident our total roster will increase significantly by next season." Last April, after just 10 days of sales to the general public because of the high volume of renewals and new purchases, so the company plans to limit sales of the pass again this year.

Sandia Peak Ski Area has been out of operation since 2022. They struggled to remain open due to staff shortages and weather challenges. Sandia hosts three double chairlifts, one surface lift, and 300 skiable acres of terrain. When the Instagram announcement was made that it was opening for 2024, comments came in from all over. Most of those were positive, from things like ""The little (O.G.) mountain that could!" and "Thank you for reviving our special corner of the ski world!" Welcome back!

TAOS SKI AREA FIRST TO USE ELECTRIC SNOWCAT: Taos Ski Valley is the world's first and only certified B Corporation ski resort and has been a certified carbon-neutral company since 2021. Taos is also a four-time *Golden Eagle Award Winner* from National Ski Areas Association which honors ski resorts' environmental initiatives. "Our goal is to reduce our carbon emissions to the greatest extent possible, which requires measurable, achievable investments - one of which is electrifying our fleet," said Dawn Boulware, Taos Ski Valley's Vice President of Social and Environmental Responsibility.

CREDIT CARD FRAUD HITS SKI AREAS: An extensive effort to sell fraudulently purchased lift tickets on Craigslist at a discounted price, with dozens of ski areas across North America being targeted, has come to the forefront. Officials at *Red Lodge Mountain*, MT recently caught on to the scam, and confronted guests who had purchased tickets from a Craigslist user for 50 percent off. Like so many people lured by the prospect of a good deal on lift tickets, the guests were unaware that it was a scam. Red Lodge got law enforcement involved to help investigate. There are more than fifty dive sites that are an interesting mix of sloping reefs, coral gardens deep pinnacles, shipwrecks, channel dives, muck diving, drift dives and sea grass beds.
